

Identify Control Measures to be Implemented

Controls considered necessary:

- In Trained operatives under 70 years of age with no government shielding requirements.
- Operatives to wear head, hearing and eye protection during employment
- 🗵 Area of work will be sectioned off and non essential people excluded from the area
- Clothing should be sturdy but allow freedom of movement. Snug fitting clothing is recommended, overalls are best. Loose fitting clothing, jewellery or anything that could become entangled with moving machine parts must be avoided. Long hair should be tied back.
- ☑ Gloves and facemask to be worn at all times, Hand sanitiser available
- ☑ Only to be used in accordance with makers instructions, which should be available.
- PPE and protective clothing removed prior to getting into any vehicle and placed in a washable storage bag. Protective wear should be washed between uses.
